

- d) To curtail local people's participation in trade of endangered animal products through active awareness and educational programs on the non-monetary values of these threatened animal species and the benefits of their protection

3. TEAM shall engage in the following activities to strengthen its environmental education resources: publication of periodicals; participating and organizing conferences and meetings; translation of classic environmental resources into Tibetan and other local languages.

4. TEAM shall also strive to educate and pressurize public authorities and states to adopt policies that are just and sustainable for everyone sharing the environment.
